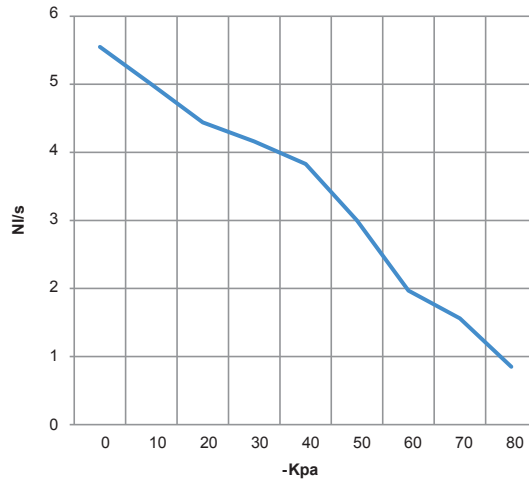

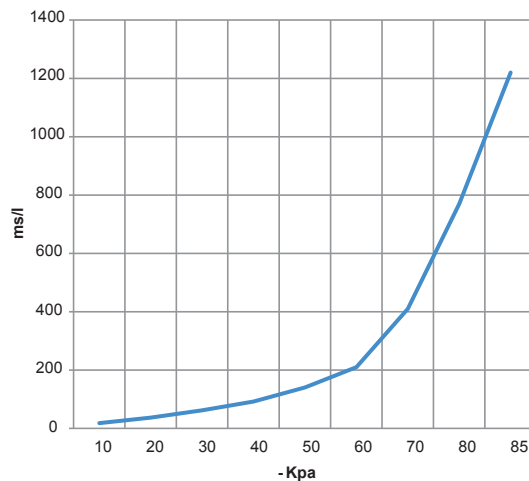


Air flow rate (NI/s) at different level of vacuum (-KPa) at optimal supply pressure
